

**NEW in 2010**

Individuals who attend Ohio's 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Special Education Leadership Conference on September 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> can earn one graduate credit hour from Ashland University by documenting and meeting attendance requirements (15 contact hours). Participants may choose among the following options to meet attendance requirements:

**Monday September 20<sup>th</sup>**

3 hours

1. Attend the pre-conference sessions or a Master Session on Monday morning, and

2. Attend the General Session on Monday afternoon, and

4.5 hours

**Tuesday September 21<sup>st</sup>**

7.5 hours

3. Attend two Master Sessions by different presenters on Tuesday, or  
Attend one Master Session and two concurrent sessions on Tuesday, or  
Attend four (4) concurrent sessions on Tuesday.

In addition, those desiring the graduate credit must turn in a paper after the conference. Participants may also be asked to document their review of vendor stations and exhibits to ensure an adequate amount of contact hours.

The cost for one graduate credit is \$175.00. Registration material will be available on site during the Conference.
